## **Lancashire Contests Registration Procedure for 2018**

**In order to register your players with us for the 2018 Brass at the Guild Contest, individual players details must be entered onto the player information sheet provided. The information sheet should be returned at least two weeks before the date of the contest. Any amendments can be made up to and on the day of the contest. For the purposes of the contest, the Contest Controller will agree directly with each band the legitimacy, within the contest rules, of all individual participants entered onto the player information sheet. On the contest day, each player is kindly requested to bring with them a form of personal ID (British passport/driving licence or other form of photographic identification, third party registration cards are acceptable as a means of personal identification only).**
